What does Lasagna Love do for National Lasagna Day?

National Lasagna Day takes place this year on July 29. In honor of this, Lasagna Love is geared to deliver at least 10,000 lasagnas to families facing food insecurity or in times of need across the globe. Over 50,000 individuals are expected to be impacted by this mass delivery.

What is the goal of this?

This global initiative not only celebrates the beloved Italian dish but serves as rallying cry for community support and kindness and embodies the spirit of compassion through every carefully prepared dish. Lasagna Love sees a homecooked meal as a culinary hug—a way of letting people know that they are never alone. This movement isn't just for those in need, but for those who need it.

How will Lasagna Love carry out these efforts?

Thousands of volunteer "lasagna chefs" from communities globally are organizing both local neighborhood gatherings and large-scale delivery events.

Has Lasagna Love celebrated National Lasagna Day in the past?

This will be the third year that Lasagna Love has organized this kind of delivery for National Lasagna Day. In 2023, Lasagna Love set an ambitious goal to deliver 10,000 lasagnas, enlist 1,000 new volunteers, and raise \$100,000 on National Lasagna Day. They exceeded the goal of 1,211 new monthly volunteers, 11,537 meals delivered and \$103,951 raised. To date, Lasagna Love has delivered 500,000 lasagnas to 2 million individuals—including 892,000 children. The organization is working to exceed the goal again 2024.
