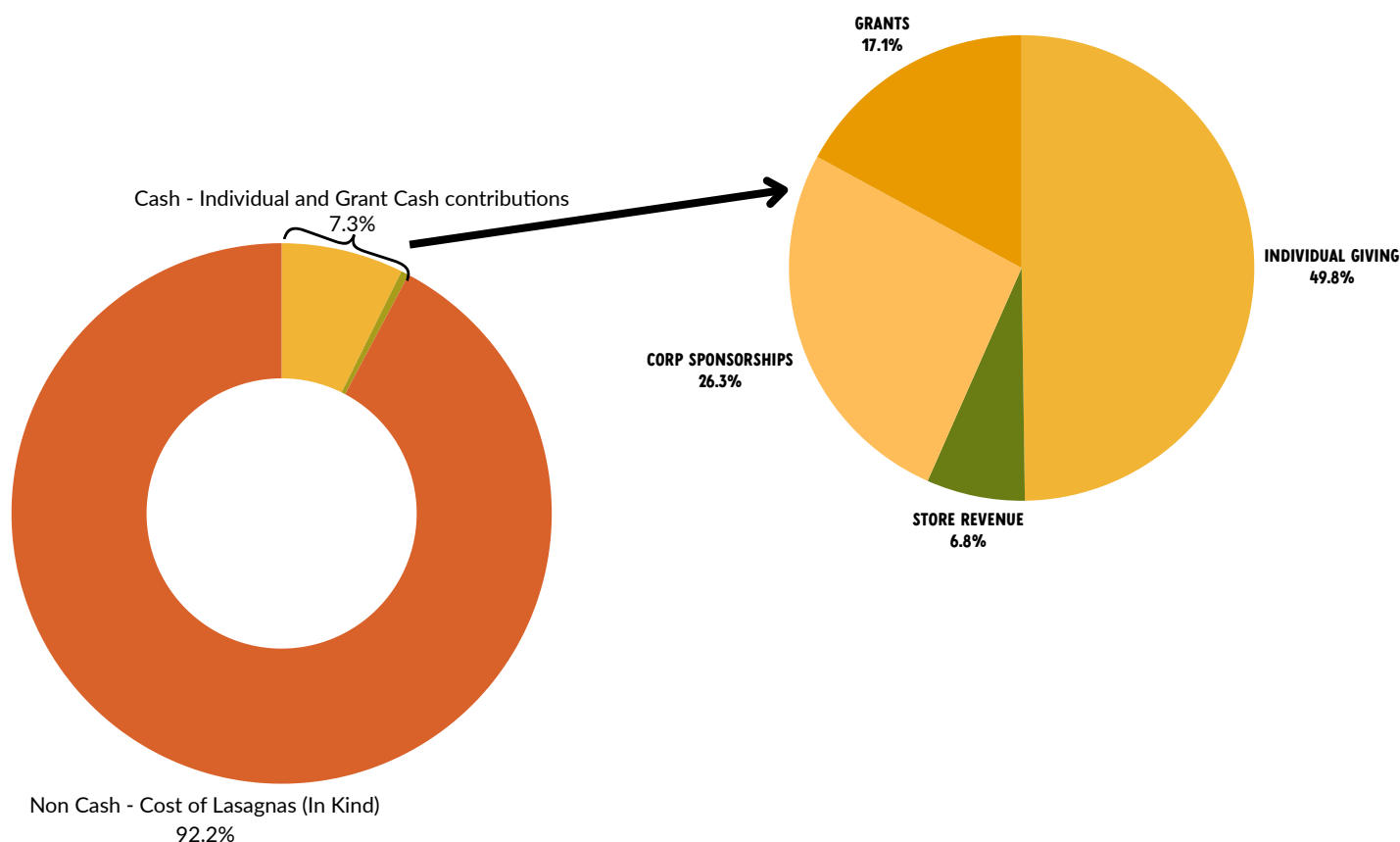

92.2% Cost of Lasagnas Delivered by Volunteers (In Kind/Non-Cash)

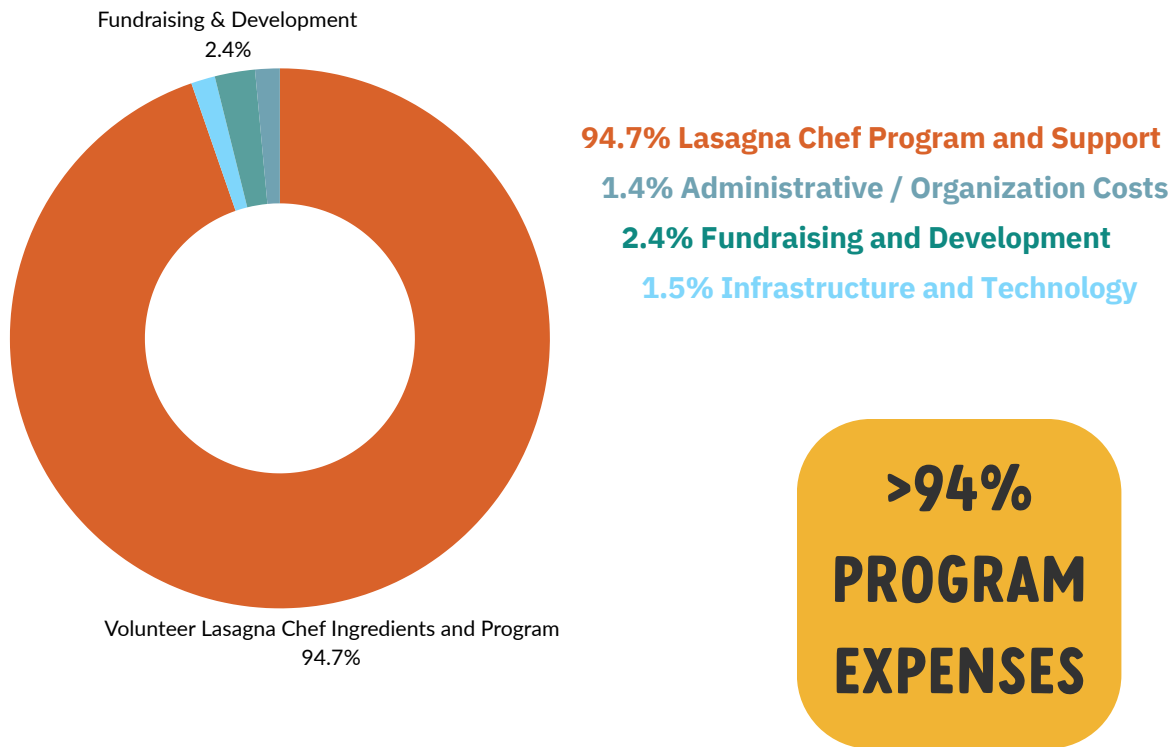
7.3% Individual & Grant Cash Contributions
